## Description

Four ceramic square-like shapes are mounted upon a vertical pillar of wood. The two largest square shapes sit next to one another on the wooden base while the two small squares sit on top of each of the larger pieces. All four of the square-like shapes are white in color and have a single band of beige on each one. The wooden base in stained in a dark tone and have wide bands of the grain.
