# Description

Geometric abstract, shapes, squares, bands, rectangles and cris-crossing images- purple and blue background with pink, and mauve colors. Overlapping fields of dull purple, pink, and blue. Two slightly arched cylindrical pink forms intersect at the bottom of the composition and extend across the surface of the foreground. The rest of

the space is filled with intersecting vertical and horizontal overlapping mauve planes that recede towards a light blue rectangle near right center of the composition.
