Bound male (a) with tonsured head on a wood and tin pedestal (b). Male is pierced by two arrows (c and d). Pedestal has a halo like circle behind the head, bearing a Zia symbol and the names of the pueblos who took place in the revolt. Piece is illuminated with LEDs behind tinwork on pedestal.
