

The ice floes' vibrant purples, the brilliant color phenomena that occur when sunlight interacts with the vast Antarctic ice fields. These images depict the fields of ice in the northeastern periphery of the Adkinsan Ridge range in the Queen Maud Land area of Antarctica. Its immense body of ice, which extends toward the ridge of the horizon in every direction, can be thousands of feet thick. With its particulate blowing constantly in the wind across the snow and its curved ground, virtually everything in this landscape is a reflecting surface, making its surface and bed light. Antarctica literally glows light within it. As sunlight moves slowly toward the environment here, it shines across and beneath the ice and snow, illuminating the horizon with vibrant color combinations.
