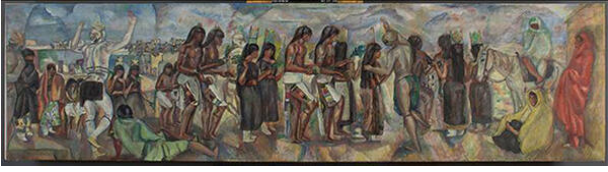

Description
