Painted and carved wood with stain, webbing, staples, metal hinges

Description

Two male figures with carved eagle mask over head, face stained brown except for cheek area, one inch from top of knee and outer lower leg painted black otherwise wood is bare and

left in its natural state. Holes are present for arms but there are no arms, head swivels.
