Description

Etched Plexiglas covers the tomb so that the shadows of the etching create a drawing. The imagery comes from a phrase created by William Wordsworth in the mid-1800' s – “pushing

up daisies” which is a reference to the state of being dead (and buried). The imagery scratched on the Plexiglas is that of looking down onto a bed of daisies.
