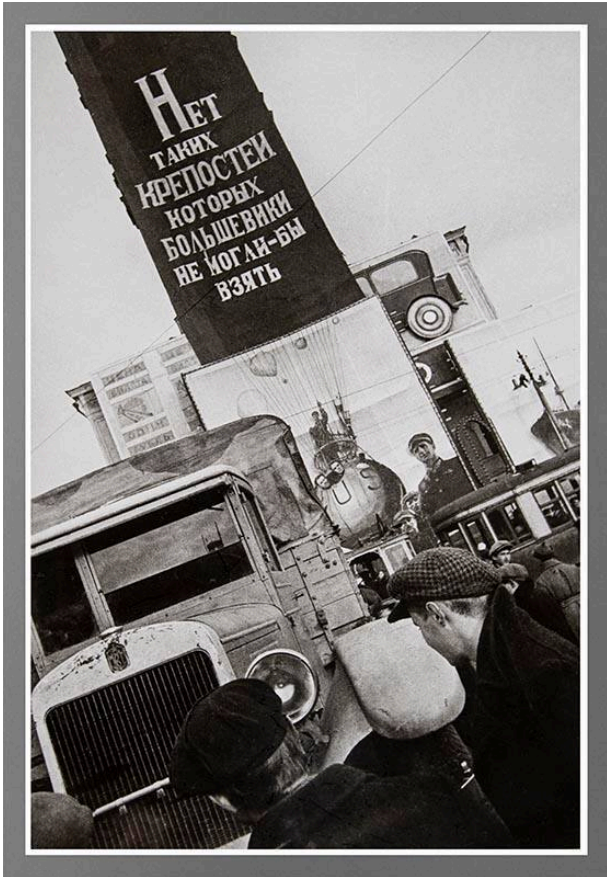




There Remains No Fortification That Bolsheviks Can Not Capture
