Description

High desert landscape with low plants from foreground to horizon. Near center foreground and at left edge are what appear to be rusted slabs of metal. At center of composition and receding into distance at an angle is a long structure, possibly made of cinder blocks, with a peaked roof and partially open doorway facing toward right. Cluster of three utility poles visible behind structure with an additional ten or so across background to the right of structure. Blue sky with long streaks of clouds.
